Jazz Vivace is a nonprofit organization dedicated to presenting performances by internationally recognized jazz artists for Cincinnati area residents. We work to position Cincinnati as a bastion of jazz performance on the international stage—as a city that attracts international jazz acts, produces internationally recognized artists, and as a home to artists who play at an world-class level.



Jazz Vivace offers companies the opportunity to engage with this diverse audience at iconic Caffè Vivace in Walnut Hills. Other performance venues include Memorial Hall in downtown, which hosted pianist Brad Mehldau. Future performances at Memorial Hall potentially include saxophonist Joe Lovano. Corporate Partnerships are created to help brands integrate authentically into the nearly 300 live concerts produced by Jazz Vivace annually.

Jazz Vivace's primary performance venue is Caffè Vivace, a coffee house by day and a jazz lounge by night. It provides a space for Cincinnatians to gather, work, socialize, and herald the musical art form of Jazz.

Brent Gallaher and Vanessa Keeton founded Caffè Vivace to return a full-time jazz listening venue to the Queen City. Caffè Vivace transitions from a coffee shop to a jazz lounge on Tuesday through Saturday evenings. Its seating is rearranged to focus everyone on the stage, and the Caffè gets in gear for a night of live Jazz from the finest musicians in Queen City.

Jazz evolved into America's great native art form in small clubs. From the French Quarter in New Orleans to 52nd Street in New York during the 1950s, brilliant artists from Louis Armstrong to Miles Davis and Charlie Parker honed their craft in intimate jazz clubs. Caffè Vivace is Cincinnati's premier Jazz performing venue, but it is not a museum celebrating the proud heritage of Jazz. It is a vibrant, exhilarating place where this great art form is pushed beyond where any of its founders could have dreamed.
